

GENERAL COVID-19 VISITATION GUIDELINES

We are very pleased to welcome you to the Berlin TV Tower with its observation deck and the world-famous revolving restaurant Sphere! Please note that our Bar 203 is temporarily closed.

From January 15, 2022, the **2G+ rule** applies to visits to the Berlin TV tower.

That means that only people who have "recovered", who are "fully vaccinated" or have received their booster dose, may be admitted. Official evidence must be submitted for this. The 2G+ obligation does not apply to people under 18 years.

At the entrance, please show one of the following documents:

- **Vaccinated:** digital vaccination certificate (e.g. Cov-Pass app) – valid from the 15th day after the second vaccination + negative test result from the same day.
- **Recovered:** a doctor's certificate of a PCR-confirmed infection (at least 28 days old, not older than 6 months) + negative test result from the same day.
- **Boosted:** digital vaccination certificate (e.g. Cov-Pass app) – valid from the day of the third vaccination.
- *between 6 and 18 years:* negative test result, not older than 24 hours.



We do everything for your safety – please help protect other guests and our employees and follow the generally recommended hygiene rules.

We kindly ask for your understanding ...

... that you may only enter the tower wearing a **mask** covering mouth and nose!

... that we keep record of the **contact details** of all visitors, to allow the tracing of infection chains if necessary. We use the app "LUCA" to do so.

Please do not plan a visit if you are suffering from acute respiratory disease or are among the at-risk groups.
